The organisational work is largely complete, and we'll soon be setting up the infrastructure on site. We'll be able to do this thanks to the 250 registered volunteers.

Thanks to the support of excellent sponsors such as Feldschlösschen, Jura Tourisme and ACI, we're able to offer you a very attractive event, despite the overall rise in prices that we're all experiencing in our daily life. We continue to do our best to keep costs for participants as low as possible. Many thanks to all our sponsors.

There will be plenty of food and drink on offer. In the party tent and in the roundel, beer consumption will probably predominate. But we're also close to wine regions. What better complement to wine than cheese, which will be on offer in the form of fondue and raclette in the fondue tent. The café will also be serving coffee and cakes throughout the day. In the evening, this area will be transformed into a cocktail bar serving simple cocktails, pastis and much more until after midnight. Beer will also be available close at hand, from the pump, fed by an underground beer pipeline. After four long years, there will probably be a lot to talk about at the bars.

We've paid a lot of attention to catering. There are more than 15 food trucks on site, other 'boutiques' are grouped together in the Jura village with suppliers from the region, and a baker will also be present every day so that nobody has to leave the site to get good baked food.

In terms of entertainment, every night from 9-11pm is show time on stage, with live performances ranging from blues to rock to a powerful live band, culminating in a huge laser show to accompany the music at the closing ceremony on Saturday. Details are available on our website.

A particular attraction will certainly be the observation tower in the middle of the site, which will allow all participants to take an aerial photo of the meeting without having to book an expensive helicopter flight.

Other attractions await you. The traditional beauty contest will be held near Delémont Castle. The vast museum will host more than 30 vehicles (Delémont tennis hall). On the grounds, games and competitions are being organised for children and adults to get everyone sweating before storming the showers building, where there are always enough showers, provided they are used respectfully. The flea market and parts market round off the entertainment on offer. It's certain that many French traders will be present, as Delémont is close to the border.

We're now looking forward to the event and hope that our promotional stand with the unmistakable 2cv Tête de Moine and the cheese and white wine tasting have been a success, and that after a long period of preparation lasting almost 6 years, we'll be able to welcome you from all over the world to experience an unforgettable 24th world meeting. We hope you'll all bring a little "JURA" home with you too.



















#### **FAQ**

The Organising Committee receives a number of recurring questions. In this section, we provide some answers to the main questions.

## I registered before the postponement of 2021, is my registration still valid?

Yes, all registrations that have been registered and paid for are valid, regardless of the date on which they were made.

#### What is included in an entry ticket?

An entry ticket includes access to the campsite for the whole week for one vehicle and 2 adults (driver and co-driver). Children born in 2007 or younger do not pay an entrance fee..

## Is it possible to bring a caravan or other vehicle?

Yes, this is possible. You just have to register your vehicle in its category. If you have a 2CV on a trailer, then you must register the 2CV as the main vehicle.

## Is it possible to have electrical access to the campsite?

No, only people who have an essential need (e.g. for health reasons) can apply for it. An area will be reserved for them.

## Is there an entrance fee for day visitors to the campsite?

No. Only registered persons are admitted to the campsite.

#### What is the entrance fee for the day at the festival site?

There is no entrance fee. Access to the festival site with its numerous animations is free for all participants and all visitors..

## Will there also be a traditional flea market for participants?

Yes, as usual every day in the morning for participants.

#### When does the campsite open and close?

The campsite will open on Tuesday 25 July at 10.00. A closing party will be held on Saturday evening, 29 July. Sunday 30 July is the departure day and the campsite must be empty by 12.00 on Monday 31 July.

## What payment systems will be available on site?

A cashless system will be available for all on-site purchases, with the exception of the flea market. Cashless cards can be loaded at the information stand by credit card (Visa, Mastercard), twint or cash (CHF, EURO).

## How can we get to Delémont easily?

A shuttle bus in the form of an oldtimer will run between the festival site and Delémont every day at different times






#### Concert Friday 28. 07.23 at 21.00 pm

**OPEN SEASON** — Keep My Fire Burning... Open Season is the number one reggae-ska band in Switzerland. With sold-out shows in the best clubs, performances at all the major Swiss festivals and several tours in European cities, the band from Bern is heating up the audience far beyond the national borders. The band has been playing on national radio stations and has releases in Europe, the USA and Japan. Open Season brings its own version of reggae, rocksteady and ska and, after more than 700 shows, knows what counts: it has to be loud and powerful.

Open Season plays ska, rocksteady and reggae. Lots of bass, jazzy horns, charismatic vocals and sophisticated electro sounds... The band's authentic sound bridges the gap between the crackle of vinyl singles and the scream of synthesizers.

CRAZY DIAMOND – The Pink Floyd Tribute — It's like a good wine: it gets better with age. Crazy Diamond has been rocking the stage for over 20 years. A couple of grey hairs may have been added, but the message remains the same: pure Pink Floyd! The fans know the songs inside out. Crazy Diamond performs them with a disconcerting authenticity, but always adds a few extra bricks to the fire. The live shows are a treat for the ears. The songs are more powerful and dynamic than on the albums, with a special flavour and a few personal notes. Songs like "Another brick in the wall", "Wish you were here" and "Time" resonate with a new strength. The band can't help but regularly dig into the archives, bringing out a long-forgotten oldie to make it shine again. So: soak up the good vibes, delve into the past, listen to "echo of a distant time", feel the goose bumps and "breathe in the air". Pink Floyd is alive!

#### **SUNDAY 30.07.23**

#### Concert Sunday 30. 07.23 at 21.00 pm

The Boogie Heads were born in 2017 from the ashes of the band Charlie Gilbert & The Rockin' Bluesmen. Charlie Gilbert (vocals, guitar), a veteran with a passion for blues and old rock, invited Charlie G., a rock guitarist since the 70's (Atlantic Sound, Longway) and Angelo Oliva, a drummer with a 25 year background in the blues and rock scene (Seven Moon, Les Talus, Kissing Toads) to join him following departures. The style and sound of the band, now renamed The Boogie Heads, took a more rock direction than before, while revitalizing some of the blues of the old repertoire.

In 2020, Claude Maître (Marenghin's rock bass player) became the band's bass player. In 2022, Luca Maturo was invited to reinforce the formation, having convinced thanks to his experience and his talents as a multi-instrumentalist (guitar, harmonica, singing).

The Boogie Heads have played an average of ten concerts per year since 2017, from Geneva to Basel, although mainly in the Jura arc. The Boogie Heads play in a natural way rock or blues in the style of the 60s and 70s, music in which they were immersed in their youth, whether through their own compositions, adaptations of some known titles or other more obscure ones. There is no doubt that The Boogie Heads will make you shake your head, tap your foot, and even jump up and down with pleasure.
